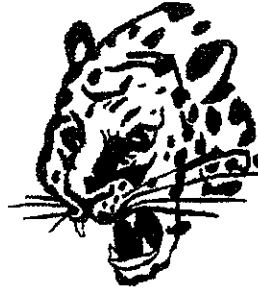


Lincoln High School Alumni Association Scholarship Application

- Applicant must have applied to a college for admission before submitting application.
- The application must be submitted by April 15th.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

1. Applicant must have a "C" average (GPA) for the past three semesters.
(Transcript required)
2. Applicant must possess leadership qualities
3. Applicant must get letters of recommendation from two of the following:
 - Guidance Counselor
 - Teacher of choice
 - Community person
4. Applicant will be responsible for getting all of his/her information to the scholarship committee on/or before April 15th.
