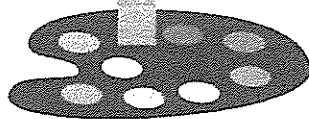
The Oak Island Art Guild offers a \$1000 Scholarship

The Scholarship Committee of the Oak Island Art Guild will accept applications from qualified graduating senior art students. After interviewing and evaluating their portfolios the most worthy student will be awarded a \$1,000 college scholarship by the guild. If it's the judgment of the Scholarship Committee that there are no acceptable candidates, the money may be awarded to past scholarship recipients continuing their art education.

Scholarship: \$1,000 award - \$500 the first term and \$500 the second term

Qualifications of Student

1. Has an unweighted 2.5 GPA minimum.
2. Will attend an accredited institution and work toward a 2 or 4 year degree in visual arts.
3. Has participated in an extracurricular activity during some portion of high school years.
4. Has recommendations from the art teacher and one senior class teacher, submitted directly to the school Guidance Office.
5. Has a portfolio of recent art work (done within the past 2 years) ready for presentation at an interview in late April or early May. This may include work done outside of school.
